The HSE consultation on the replacement of the CDM Regulations 2007 started on 31 March 2014 and ended on 6 June 2014. The new regulations came into force in April 2015. The key change item saw the CDM Coordinator role revoked and replaced by a Principal Designer function, that has taken on the majority of the responsibilities previously held by the CDM Coordinator.
